## FIREFIGHTER I-II RECRUIT ACADEMY

12 Weeks/480 Hours

This course will prepare the entry-level firefighter to meet Washington State certifications for Fire Fighter I and Hazardous Materials Awareness and Operations. Individuals desiring to attain the advanced level of Fire Fighter II can continue for an additional two weeks of training to include IFSAC certification testing.

**The two additional weeks of Fire Fighter II training is not mandatory. Students may elect to attend an 80-hour firefighter II class at a later date. Positions may be available for additional Firefighter 2 students.**
